- ✓ After first discussing the idea of changing the System's name in 2019, we have finally accomplished this long-time goal.
- ✓ "OWWL Library System" has been approved by the Board of Regents as well as provisional approval by the IRS
- Our next steps are to continuing rolling out the name change on our financial paperwork and with the Division of Library Development.



## **FY 2022 Budget and Beyond**

### 2022 Budget

We are on target to have a modest surplus that will help stabilize our contingency reserve fund, provide minor renovations to the System building, and to help promote "OWWL Library System."

### 2023 and Beyond

We are estimating flat funding in 2023, however, there may be a downturn in State Ed. funding moving forward. Luckily, we have planned for those possibilities and will be able to operate relatively uninterrupted should State Aid receive a cut.








































