Digital literacy workshops at Dormann

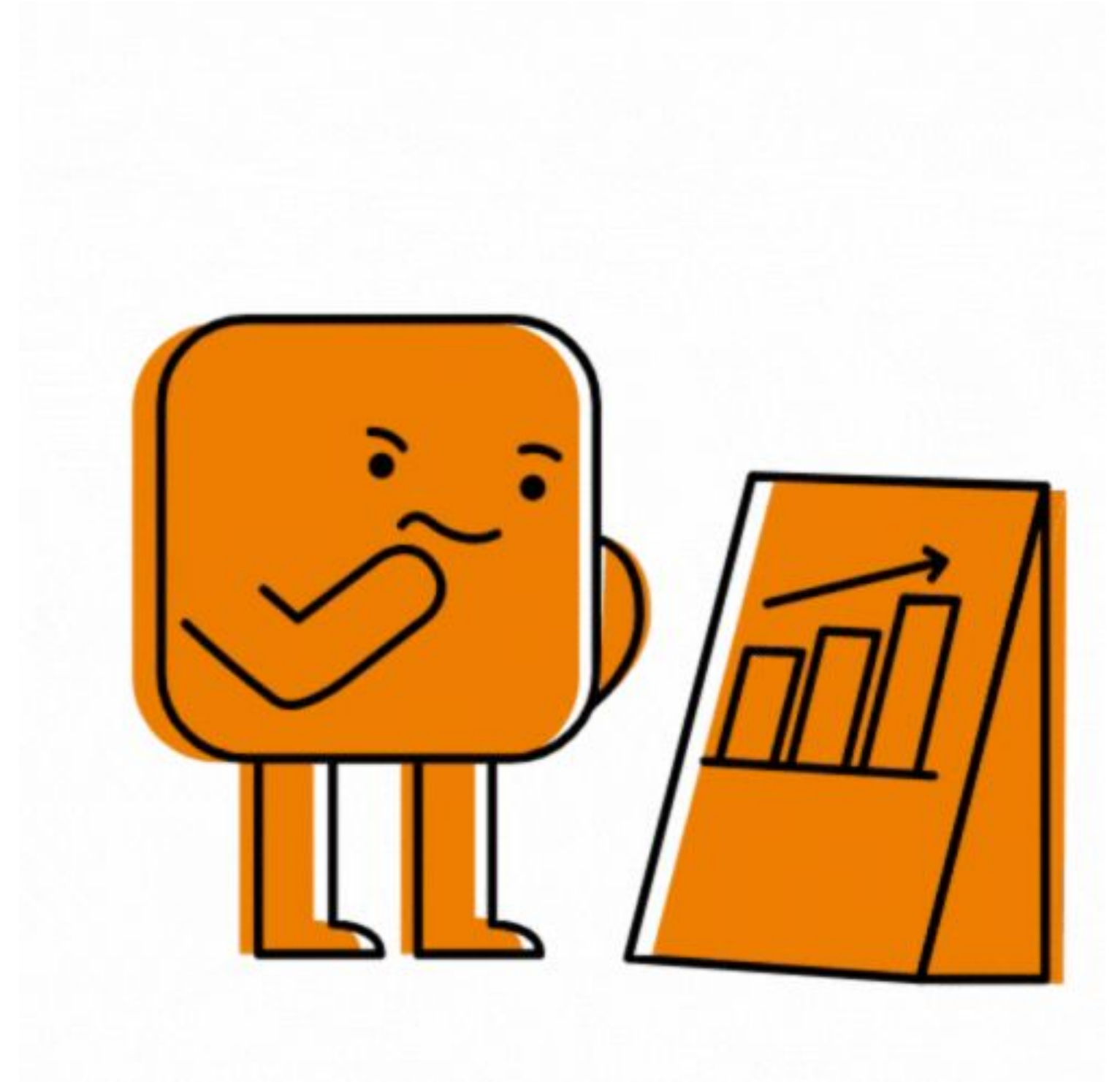
- We had only a few people come to our 65+ digital literacy classes.
