
Quarterly Usage Statistics May 20, 2011

Ask Us 24/7

Local use (defined as patrons identifying themselves as Geneva Public Library patrons, or using the Qwidget on our website) has increased significantly during the first 4 months of 2011. In March 2010, 7 local patrons used the service; in March of 2011, 19 local patrons used the service. By the end of April, we have exceeded our total number of local questions answered for all of 2010: 47 so far this year, compared to a total of 32 last year.
