Revised 2011 Budget & Allocations

- The actual reduction in state aid was 23%
- After discussion, the budget allocations were changed as follows:
 - o Nonfiction books: \$17,329.29
 - Cathy suggested putting more funds toward test prep materials to make up for the lingering loss of LearnATest
 - o Reference books: \$3,000.00
 - Beth and Carol discussed GPL and Wood Library resource-sharing Morningstar Investment Survey and ValueLine. Beth will contact Ron to plan for this
 - Nonfiction audibooks: \$2,500.00
 - Nonfiction DVDs: \$2,000.00
 - The lowest circulating (outside of GPL) materials are DVD sets. Member requests for these items should be weighed against the cost and need
 - Perhaps a list of DVD sets available at GPL should be sent out to member libraries to increase use?
 - Nonfiction OverDrive: \$7,000.00
 - By title count, 70% eBook and 30% audio
