

Kindle Fire OverDrive Download instructions

These are basic instructions for downloading books to a Kindle Fire.

After entering Owwl2go

Do an advance search for kindle books only. This way you don't find books that aren't kindle compatible.

Side note: not all ebooks work on a Kindle.

Within a few minutes (at most a few hours) your book should be on your Kindle Fire.

Your book will be returned to OWWL2go and removed from your Kindle Fire.

If you don't wish to return your book early the book will be returned automatically at the end of the loan period and removed from you Kindle Fire.
