<u>Melissa (CS)</u>: Announced the Newark's Youth Services Librarian, Krystina Hardter, is the Interim Director at Newark Library. The search for a new director is on-going.

<u>Cathy (LIM)</u>: Lima received a Target Grant to enable them to hire a Theatre Troupe from MA for 2 days of performances and workshop.

<u>Melissa (CS)</u>: Clifton was awarded a NY Reading and Discussion Grant and this is their 3rd series. Newark was also awarded this grant. Program requires a theme, budget, and must be scholar facilitated. (loose definition, CS has a former educator, and resume is sent in with application) Easy to apply for grant. 1st year Clifton picked from the list of themes; after that, chose their own.

<u>Jenny (CAN)</u>: Wood Library's upcoming fundraiser Super Star Showcase & Extravaganza, Sept 14. Held at FLCC, 7pm. This year library is spending \$ to make \$. A wide variety of acts such as Rochester Ballet, sword swallower, juggler—will keep the audience guessing.

Construction at the library is on-going.

<u>Janet (PER)</u>: The United Way's community calendar has a listing of libraries in Livingston & Wyoming counties and community events. Call and they will send. The calendar is designed with pre-schoolers in mind.

Perry received funding from Rotary to design a library calendar as a give-away. It contains activities following the RAP – *Read Around Perry* theme.

<u>Wendy (HPL)</u>: Honeoye received a DEC grant (Decentralization) that is funding a potter in residence. The artist is making tiles in the library's basement area that will fill a 4'x6' wall space, need about 300 tiles. Artist helps residents make and then help with install. A great educational opportunity. A cool partnership and the library will have a permanent display.

Wendy spoke about her experience working with WXXI recording for a segment for NPR on Role of Libraries in American Life. NPR contacted ALA who gave them a list of NYS libraries that loaned fishing poles and Honeoye was chosen. The program also talked about Human Libraries.

- Library partnerships, What can libraries do?
 - Spend time reviewing the NYS of Health website
 - \circ Assign a point person as the go-to for keeping up with resources and keeping staff informed
 - Review computer access policies

- What can PLS do?
 - Can PLS have a Point Person Boot Camp? Will help libraries provide consistent info and to keep informed
 - Should a general press release be issued about the role of libraries in our area? Perhaps a preventative and positive press release letting folks know the libraries' role
 - Provide staff with a script describing the libraries' role; so each is confident of where to draw the line. Staff are not insurance/medical experts
 - Keep list of navigators assigned to each county
- Williamson on Sept 30 at 5 pm, a free Educational Workshop on the Affordable Care Act for Small Business Owners. The workshop is being presented by the S2AY Network a Rural Health Network funded by the New York State Department of Health as part of their small business assistance program.

Free Direct Access (FDA) Plan

Facilitator: Betsy Morris

- Steps to finalizing the 2013 FDA Plan:
 - o Review draft
 - Member libraries comment/feedback
 - o Revisions
 - Final draft take to the library boards (need over 50% to approve)
- Review talking points as you review the draft and talk to your boards
- Note highlighted areas on document. There is a fine balance between providing free access and considering your chartered service area taxpayers. May need to set priorities for computer usage and program attendance. We want to define inequities.
- It is very important to code properly when issuing a library card. All usage statistics consider these entries
- **Opportunity**: As you do renewals for library cards, pay attention to the residency codes and school codes
- OWWLAC will also address FDA; please contact your representative or Betsy or Lindsay
- Betsy will be happy to attend the September 6 PLSDAC meeting to further discuss the FDA plan
