






Perks

Perks



- All you need is a camera, an internet connection, and a Google account
- YouTube is very easy to use
- After the live broadcast is done, the video is automatically uploaded to YouTube and ready to be shared
- You can edit videos


What is a digital badge?

- Think Army badges or Boy & Girl Scout badges, but online




