


Defer judgment Encourage wild ideas Build on the ideas of others


Stay focused on the topic

And... Stick to the rules!





Five Techniques for Brain- Storming








1. Mind – Storming

Ex 4. What programs should be included in the 2015 NYLA Conference? (100 ideas 15 minutes)

100 ideas, are you crazy? Why?

The early ideas are the easiest and least creative. Real creativity occurs after the easy ideas have been said.

5. Brand - Storming



Ex 5. What would a community room look like for college age library users?

BRAND: Target
