




Standard #7: Hours

- Hours should include morning, afternoon, evening, and weekend
- Temporary changes to hours due to COVID-19 will be a Note on Annual Report to New York State

Up to 500	12
500-2,499	20
2,500-4,999	25
5,000-14,999	35
15,000—24,999	40
25,000-99,999	55
100,000 and above	60
