Application is open to all employees working in the 42 OWWL Libraries and System headquarters who identify as women, regardless of job title or career stage

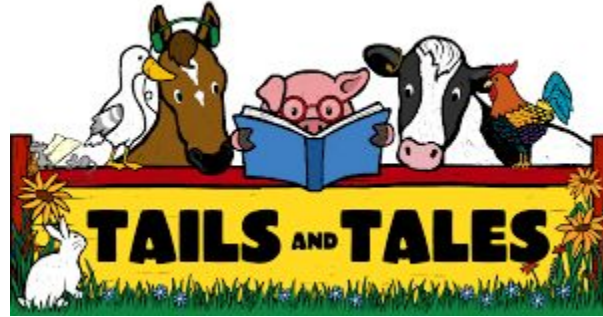

7-Day Grace Period

- 7-day grace period still in effect
- Overdue fines don't post until after the grace period
 - Item 4 days overdue? No overdue fines!
- Item still overdue past the end of the grace period?
 - Item 9 days overdue? 9 days of overdue fines!



OOS Barcodes / Alerts

- Alert added to patrons whose card is an obsolete purple and gold OOS card:
 - “Please offer patron a new library card to replace obsolete purple and yellow out-of-system card and then delete this alert”
