NY Paid Sick Leave

“We've confirmed my understanding regarding application of the New York State Paid Sick Leave requirements. As noted below in language copied from the relevant State website, and at the link provided, the requirement applies to private sector employers only. This means that it applies to association libraries, but not to public libraries (i.e., municipal, school district, or special district public libraries).”

Eligibility

All private-sector employees in New York State are covered, regardless of industry, occupation, part-time status, and overtime exempt status. Federal, state, and local government employees are **NOT** covered, but employees of charter schools, private schools, and not-for-profit corporations are covered.

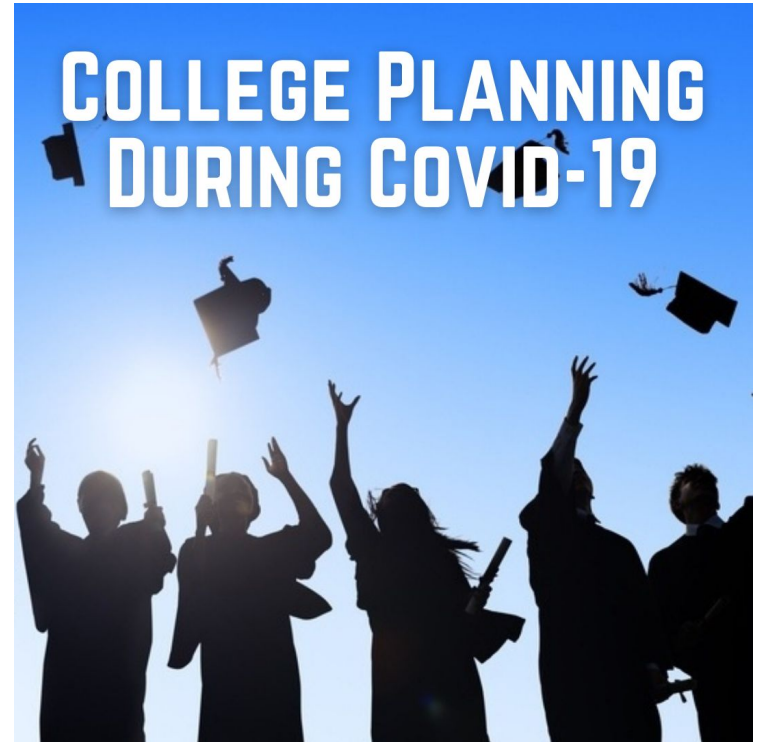
