











TechSoup - History

- In December of 2021 Microsoft switched Libraries to Academic Licensing
- Prior to that time we qualified for Nonprofit donations
- This included a significant price increase
- In early 2022 many libraries applied and failed to get qualified as Academic with Microsoft
- By July it was clear the Academic experiment failed.
- On 10/18/2022 TechSoup announced we qualify for Nonprofit pricing again.



TechSoup - Today

For Microsoft products there are two types of Licensing.

- Donations
 - Public computers only
 - Office Standard No Software Assurance (Computer Labs Only) (\$36.00 each)
- Discounts
 - All other computers
 - Office Standard (Discounted) No Software Assurance (\$118.00 each)



TechSoup - Purchasing

- The process has changed for Microsoft products
- A new Microsoft cloud account is required with 2 factor authentication linked to a cell phone
- May cause issues when directors change positions
- OWWL may be able to help with centralized purchasing but for Staff licenses only.
- Public donations are limited to 50 licenses



Microsoft Office

"No Software Assurance" is a cheaper option. Buy the current version and keep it for the full lifetime.

Microsoft has reduced the lifetime down to 5 years. Office 2021 expires in October 2026. (2016 and 2019 expire Oct 2025)

If your Microsoft Office is older than 2016, consider upgrading to 2021.



Microsoft Office for Public

Why do we continue to promote Microsoft Office for Public?

- 11+ of our libraries have had Libre Office on public computers for 4+ years. Libre is free and open source.
- Free online office suites offer many advantages
 - Google Docs, Sheets and Slides are all free
 - Office.com (Now Microsoft 365) is free
 - Documents are stored online so patrons can take them wherever they go. Including phone apps.
