### Old Business

#### ● **Annual Report Statistics Re-Run (Suzanne Macaulay)**

##### Definition of a Program

- Previously simply 'Programs' is now *Synchronous Program*
- Synchronous programs have REAL TIME participation; can be in-person or virtual.
- Virtual programs can be real time (synchronous) or pre-recorded (asynchronous).
  - IF it has REAL TIME PARTICIPATION in-person, it is a Synchronous Program.
  - IF it has REAL TIME PARTICIPATION in-person and also live-streamed (via Zoom or Facebook) it is a Synchronous Program.
  - IF it has REAL TIME PARTICIPATION but only online and not in-person, it is a *Synchronous Virtual Program*.
  - IF the program is ONLY delivered using pre-recorded material, it is an *Asynchronous Virtual Program*.

##### Statistics to keep

- Record the number of programs offered on site verses *off campus*. Only total number of each is necessary; no longer broken down.
- Number of in-person *Synchronous Programs* and attendance at each.

- Number of *Synchronous Virtual Program Sessions* offered AND the number of views. (In this case, think of each view as an attendant to the program.)
- Number of *Asynchronous Virtual Program Sessions* offered AND the number of views. (In this case, think of each view as an attendant to the program.)
  - IF you hold a live program with a virtual option, you should report the total (in person and virtual) attendance for Synchronous Program Sessions.
  - If you record a synchronous (live) program and upload it for further viewing, you can count it additionally as an Asynchronous Virtual Program and should report the number of views
