Programs – Revised definition of library programs

- Everything that has previously been called Programs is now called Synchronous Programs
- Programs happening LIVE (all in-person programs and some virtual programs) are now referred to as Synchronous Program Sessions

Virtual Programs – There will now be four categories:

- 1. Synchronous Virtual Program Sessions (live-streaming)
- 2. Synchronous Virtual Program Attendance
- 3. Asynchronous Virtual Program Sessions (pre-recorded)
- 4. Asynchronous Virtual Program Views (in first 7 days after posting)

Programs – Definition of Children's Programs

- Previously the definition of children's programs encompassed those offered for ages 0-11
- As of January 2022, libraries should use 0-5 and 6-11 age categories

Programs – General Interest

- New program type
- Any program that encourages/allows a range of ages such as family game nights, holiday programs, chess clubs, etc.
- > It must include, but not be limited to, adults

Programs – Location

- Two new questions will break out total program sessions between in-library and off-site
- > These will not be subdivided by age groups
- There will not be questions on attendance, just total numbers of programs
